Despite Iceland's high latitude and relatively low insolation, recent advancements in solar technology have made photovoltaic (PV) systems more efficient and cost-effective. Iceland receives about 20% less yearly insolation than Paris and half as much as Madrid, with very limited solar energy available during the winter months.

The location at Akureyri, Northeast, Iceland is not the most ideal for year-round solar energy production. However, it does have potential during certain times of the year. In summer and spring, you can expect a good amount of electricity output from solar PV installations - 5.01kWh/day in Summer and 4.12kWh/day in Spring per kW of installed solar.

The material produced will be used in making solar panels. 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Photovoltaic is one of the popular technologies of renewable DG units, especially in the MGs. The photovoltaic panel is a solar system that utilizes solar cells or solar photovoltaic arrays to turn directly the solar irradiance into electrical power. In other words, photons of light are absorbed in photovoltaic arrays and thus electrons are released in the panel.

Photovoltaics (often shortened as PV) gets its name from the process of converting light (photons) to electricity (voltage), which is called the photovoltaic effect. This phenomenon was first exploited in 1954 by scientists at Bell Laboratories who created a working solar cell made from silicon that generated an electric current when exposed to sunlight.

In total, 93% of the global population lives in countries that have an average daily solar PV potential between 3.0 and 5.0 kWh/kWp. Around 70 countries boast excellent conditions for solar PV, where average daily output exceeds 4.5 kilowatt hours per installed kilowatt of capacity (kWh/kWp) - enough to boil around 25 liters of water.
