



Cambodia's new solar photovoltaic panels

Does Cambodia have solar power?

Solar power capacity has been on a sharp ascent in Cambodia recently, increasing at a 10% annual rate from less than 1% of national generation capacity, however. Some 400-MW of solar-fueled power capacity is now connected to the national grid, according to the Department of Mines and Energy.

Will solar power be a key part of Cambodia's Power Development Plan?

The country recently approved the Power Development Masterplan (2021-2040), covering an inspiring goal of increasing solar PV capacity to 1,000 MW by 2030 and 3,000 MW by 2040. Solar generation will need to be a key part of Cambodia's efforts to expand access to affordable power while also transitioning to cleaner energy.

Can large-scale solar PV be developed in Cambodia?

It is regarded as a convincing example demonstrating the potential to develop cost-effective large-scale solar PV in Cambodia by uniting the public and private sectors. Phase II of the solar park, which totals 40 MW, was tendered in 2020 and awarded to Trina Solar with another record-low price of \$0.026 per kWh.

Will Cambodia build a 100 mw National Solar Park?

Cambodia's recent solar power tender is the first of a two-phase auction process that falls under development of a plan to build a 100-MW National Solar Park in Kampong Chhnang province.

Are solar power projects a good investment in Cambodia?

Krungthai COMPASS, a financial advisory firm, estimates that solar power projects in Cambodia can generate attractive returns on investment, with an internal rate of return (IRR) ranging from 4.18% to 19.35% and an average payback period of 4.9 to 12.3 years, depending on the electricity selling price offered in the auction.

How many solar power plants are in Phnom Penh?

For solar energy investment, the plan aims to increase power generation capacity by approximately 2,450 megawatts, with an investment value of about 48 billion baht. This will involve developing 39 solar power plants across 11 provinces, including Phnom Penh, Kampong Chhnang, Kampong Speu, and Kampong Thom.

However, Cambodian households and private enterprises are increasingly investing in photovoltaic systems as an alternative power source. Solar exports predict that Cambodia's solar market could grow at 10% annually owing to this new development. At the moment, Cambodia enjoys a good presence of solar product producers and suppliers.

History of Rooftop Solar in Cambodia Before 2018 there was no regulation for customers wishing to install solar. However, customers started installing solar systems as the global cost of solar was rapidly declining. There were cases of EDC requiring rooftop solar systems to be removed or turned off, rumours about a new

regulation.

Cambodia's solar panel exports to the U.S. have grown rapidly in the last three years, valued at \$18 million in 2019 and rising to \$233 million last year, according to UN Comtrade data. The second highest importer of Cambodian solar, India, imported \$4.4 million worth of photovoltaic cells in 2021.
