

Cambodia's photovoltaic energy storage policy

Is solar PV a good investment in Cambodia?

At present, the use of solar PV and wind power generation in Cambodia is small compared to other countries, both in the ASEAN region and internationally. The development of solar PV generation is expected to improve the overall energy sector in Cambodia.

Is a new solar policy a positive development for Cambodia?

Despite leaving many questions unanswered, Ngo Son sees the new policy as a positive development for solar in Cambodia. This April, the Cambodian government approved five renewable energy projects totaling 520 MW.

Does Cambodia have solar power?

However, considering the country's historical energy mix, the existing solar capacity appears positive. As of 2011, Cambodia had no solar power plants, and solar energy was not a part of the country's energy mix. Cambodia's current installed solar capacity is slightly over 400 MW, but the country is targeting 3.1 GW by 2040.

Can Cambodia permit rooftop solar power?

At the end of April, the nation's Ministry of Mines and Energy published a document, "Principles for permitting the use of rooftop solar power in Cambodia" that outlines new principles to streamline the permitting process of rooftop PV. It proposes the replacement of actual capacity charges with new tariffs and quotas for installations.

Why is Cambodia developing 2 gigawatts of solar power?

The development of 2 gigawatts of solar power is in line with the strategy of the Cambodian government to meet its growing energy demand by maximizing the adoption of renewable energy and energy efficiency.
