Does Scatec have a solar power plant in Cameroon?

10 June 2024, Cameroon/Norway: Release by Scatec has entered into two new lease agreements with the national electricity company ENEO in Cameroon, expanding its existing solar and battery storage power plants in the country to 64.4 MW of solar and 38.2 MWh of batteries.

Will Cameroon have a solar power plant?

The Maroua and Guider power plants, Cameroon's first public solar project with a combined capacity of 30 MW, were commissioned by MINEE in September 2023. Additionally, a 20 MW solar power plant is planned for the city of Garoua.

Where are Eneo solar & battery storage plants located in Cameroon?

Release entered into a lease agreement with ENEO, an electricity company, in 2021 to deliver two solar hybrid and battery storage plants that have a combined capacity of 36 MW solar and 20 MW/19 MWh of storage. The plants are located in Maroua and Guider, in the Grand-North Cameroon.

When is release by Scatec launching solar plants in Cameroon?

22 September 2023, Cameroon: Today, Release by Scatec celebrates the inauguration of the solar plants in Cameroon. Release entered into a lease agreement with ENEO, an electricity company, in 2021 to deliver two solar hybrid and battery storage plants that have a combined capacity of 36 MW solar and 20 MW/19 MWh of storage.

How much energy will release supply in Cameroon?

When the extensions of the projects are completed, Release's projects in totality will supply energy to about 200,000 households in Cameroon, according to ENEO estimates, generating an annual production of about 141.5 GWh of electricity.

What is the energy potential of Cameroon?

Government Strategies for Energy Production Cameroon's energy potential primarily comprises hydroelectricity (64%), thermal energy (30%), and other renewable energies (about 6%). The installed capacity increased from 933 MW to 1650 MW by 2020, falling short of the planned target of 3000 MW by a deficit of 1350 MW.

Energy supply. Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored.
