When using solar panels with varying wattage ratings in conjunction with one another, it is imperative that the appropriate wiring system be selected in order to connect the individual panels. The wiring system can be connected in either series or parallel, and the correct choice will depend on the wattage of the panels.

How many volts can a solar panel run in a series?

When solar panels are connected in a series, 60V is obtained for 100W panels and 60V for 200W arrays. If connected in parallel, the voltage remains 60V, but the amperage increases to 15A. The maximum possible output is 900W (60V x 15A). You can connect similar PV modules in a series and then connect the strings in parallel.
