



Can solar lights be placed outdoors

Do solar lights work in shade?

Ideally, the more sunlight the solar panels will receive, the better, but that's not to say solar lights won't work in partially shaded areas. Consider where sunlight is best in your garden and try charging up the panels there before permanently placing them.

Where should solar lights be placed?

Placement also depends on the type of solar lights you choose. If your solar lights were bought with practicality in mind, such as lighting a pathway or shining a spotlight on the patio, you know the result you want to achieve and this can give you a rough indication of where to place them.

How far apart should outdoor landscape lights be placed?

To ensure your pathway remains bright and well-lit, it is preferable to put outdoor landscape lights six to eight feet apart. However, you can place them even closer for an especially vivid effect.

Take patio and deck lighting beyond the standard porchlight by mounting solar lights to the trunks of nearby trees.

It's also good to check that any leaves or vegetation won't block the solar panels too. The lights won't be as bright if they can't effectively charge. Keep the panels away from any other light sources, such as windows, so they won't mistake the light for daylight and switch off at night.

How far apart should solar lights be placed? As a general rule, smaller profile lighting for residential use should be placed 6 - 8 feet apart while commercial applications that require more lighting should be placed 4 - 6 feet apart.

Ideally, outdoor solar lights should be placed in areas where they can receive full sunlight for about eight hours a day. This may be easy for those living in sunny Southern California, but others with less favorable conditions (looking at you, Seattle) should consider consulting a solar- or landscape-lighting professional for optimal ...
