

Can't outdoor power supply be charged indoors

Is it safe to use an indoor cord outside?

A: It is not safe to use an indoor cord outdoors. These cords are only designed for indoor use. They do not have adequate insulation or protection from the weather that outdoor conditions require. Q: What's the difference between an indoor and outdoor cord?

Can you use an extension cord outside?

Because it is not weatherproofed and lacks insulation, using an indoor extension cord outside is very dangerous. Moisture exposure can cause short circuits, electric shock, or even fire with these cords, which are designed for indoor use only. They have a lower amperage rating, too - so they cannot power high-power-consuming outdoor equipment.

Why are outdoor extension cords rated at higher amperages?

Commonly, outdoor extension cords are rated at higher amperages to meet the needs of power tools used in gardens or yards and other outdoor lighting fixtures such as those found along driveways and sidewalks, etcetera.

Are outdoor rated cords GFCI protected?

Outdoor rated cords have a heavier, much heavier, insulation to protect them from the outdoor environment, sun, UV, animals, etc. The male and female ends are also insulated heavier and are of higher quality. Connecting to a weatherproof box is not the same as indoor use and if the outlet is outdoors, it will have to be GFCI protected.

What is the difference between indoor and outdoor extension cords?

The insulation and material durability are the two main characteristics that differentiate between indoor and outdoor extension cords. For example, an indoor cord may have lighter insulation because it is meant to be used in controlled environments where there is no contact with water or temperature extremes.
