Colombia's 2019 renewable energy auction awarded contracts for nine wind and five solar projects. These projects are worth approximately \$8 billion and will add 1,365 MW of wind and solar capacity, due to be commissioned by 2022.

Colombia committed to the Energy Transition process with the election of President Duque in 2018. His administration set a goal to increase unconventional renewable energy generation from 1 percent to more than 12 percent in the energy matrix by 2022, and raise the reduction of emissions of greenhouse gases (GHG) from 20 percent to 51 percent by 2030.

Colombia launched the Energy Plan 2050 in 2016, which aims to diversify the country's energy resources and ensure a reliable energy supply. The Plan also aims to include wind power plants, solar PV and geothermal energy generation in the country's elec
