



Construction of a large-scale energy storage project in Congo

Will cigenco and nzuri energy build a large-scale solar power plant?

Kinshasa, the Democratic Republic of Congo, November 25, 2021 - To scale up clean energy production capacity in the Democratic Republic of Congo, IFC, Globeleq, CIGenCo, Greenshare Energy, Greenshare Congo, Volt Renewables, and Nzuri Energy have partnered to develop a large-scale solar power production plant in the country.

How much power does DR Congo have?

According to the latest figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency, DR Congo only had 20 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2020. The country has one of the lowest levels of access to electricity in the world, with only 9% of the population being supplied with power. This percentage in rural areas drops to as far as 1%.

How many people in DRC have electricity?

According to World Bank data, only about 19 percent of DRC's population had access to electricity in 2019. The project was originally developed by CIGenCo, Greenshare Energy, Greenshare Congo, Volt Renewables, and Nzuri Energy. IFC and Globeleq (as lead developer) have come on board to drive the project forward and help it reach completion.

When will DR Congo's solar power plants be built?

The plants are to be built by the Moyi Power joint venture and are expected to be completed within 18 months after the start of construction. According to the latest figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency, DR Congo only had 20 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2020.

What do we do in the Republic of Congo?

Our activities in the Republic of Congo are aimed at improving the quality of life of the population and the socioeconomic development of the area. This is a challenge we are engaged in on several fronts such as the valorisation of gas, electricity production and supply, access to drinking water, and modernisation of daily food cooking systems.

Will a \$100 million solar project power Gemena & Bumba & Isiro?

An international consortium led by Powergrids plans to invest \$100 million in three off-grid solar plants intended to power the cities of Gemena, Bumba, and Isiro, which are located in the country's northern region and currently have no connection to the country's power network.

Construction has started on what will be the largest battery storage project in Belgium at 25MW/100MWh when completed later this year. Nala Renewables' lithium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS) will come online at metals conglomerate Nyrstar's zinc smelting operation in Balen, in Belgium's Flemish region,

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by the end of 2022.

For Nuru, commissioning the Goma smart power plant was the first step in a large-scale project to forge economic and social development. In February 2020, six months after construction this 1.3MW hybrid solar project was ready to supply outlying areas of Goma City that were side-lined from electrification projections.

More than AU\$1 billion (US\$0.65 billion) of financial commitments to large-scale battery energy storage system (BESS) projects were made in Australia in the second quarter of this year. If hybrid (generation-plus-storage) projects were to also be counted, the investment commitments exceed AU\$2 billion.

The first major utility-scale battery storage project was energised in 2017 - a 50MW/25MWh project in Pelham, developed and owned by Staterra Energy. Going forward, deployment levels are likely to see annual increases; ...

As of mid-2022, Germany's biggest BESS project was Lausitz Battery Energy Storage System (60MW/52MWh), at a coal plant operated by generator LEAG. Utility-scale BESS market action in Australia, with developers Akaysha Energy, Firm Power and ACE Power receiving key project approvals. Although not on the scale individually of either Chinese project, some megawatt-scale flow battery projects have been completed, announced or begun construction in recent months around the world. In the UK, the world's largest battery storage system to hybridise lithium-ion and vanadium flow went officially into commercial operation this ...

Infratec general manager Nick Bibby said that the storage system is "the first of its scale to be built in New Zealand". As reported by Energy-Storage.news, the two companies completed their assessment of the project in late 2021, selecting a site in Huntly, a town in the Waikato District.. They then announced the appointment of key contractors in March of last ...

A major pumped storage project currently under construction is the Snowy 2.0, a project that has been described as Australia's largest renewable energy project. It will link Tantangara Reservoir (top storage) with Talbingo Reservoir (bottom storage) through 27km of tunnels and a power station with pumping capabilities.

In the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), several pioneering renewable energy storage initiatives stand out as exemplars of innovation, including Project 1: Inga Dam Complex, recognized for its significant hydroelectric capacity, Project 2: Solar Power Storage ...

The Alfeld project is Kyon's second large-scale BESS project approval in the space of a few weeks, after a 58MW/116MWh system was given the green light by regulators at the end of October. It will be built near an ...

2023 also saw AU\$4.9 billion (US\$3.2 billion) in new financial commitments for utility-scale energy storage and hybrid projects with storage, an increase from AU\$1.9 billion (US\$1.2 billion) in 2022. Q2 2023 alone saw ...

Recent examples include US\$24 million in World Bank guarantees for equity and shareholder loan investments into a solar-plus-storage project in Malawi, which also received a US\$25 million DFC loan guarantee, a tender launched in August in the Maldives for 40MWh of BESS and energy management system (EMS) contracts for 18 islands supported by the ...

In November 2023, the developer Kyon Energy received approval to build a new large-scale battery storage project in the town of Alfeld in Lower Saxony, Germany. At the same time, German regulators extended the grid-fee exemptions for new BESS systems by three years to 2029, further incentivizing developers to build out BESS in the country.

Towards the end of 2023, power company Suomen Voima, which already owns five hydropower plants in Norway, announced its intention to develop a new energy storage project: Noste, in Northern Finland. They will construct up to three small-scale PSH plants, for a total capacity of more than 100MW and a total investment of up to EUR300 million.

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
