Who owns Capricornia hydroelectric storage system (PHES)?

Gamuda, in a joint venture with Ferrovial (GFJV), has signed an Early Contractor Involvement (ECI) agreement with Capricornia Energy Hub (CEH) for its Capricornia Pumped Hydroelectric Storage System (PHES). CEH is owned by Copenhagen Infrastructure Partners (CIP), one of the world's largest clean energy investors.

What is the hydrogen power project in Copenhagen?

The hydrogen power project in Copenhagen is a large-scale facility powered by offshore wind. When fully scaled up by 2030, it is expected to deliver more than 250,000 tonnes of fuel to the industry and reduce annual carbon emissions by up to 850,000 tonnes.

Where is Queensland's pumped hydro storage project located?

Delivery of the integrated renewable energy and pumped hydro storage project, located approximately 80 kilometres west of Mackay in Central Queensland, will play an important role in Queensland's future energy mix and provide affordable and reliable energy for around 900,000 Queensland homes.

How many jobs will the Capricornia pumped hydroelectric energy system create?

Construction of the Capricornia Pumped Hydroelectric Energy System is expected to begin in 2026. It will create an estimated 600 jobs during peak construction and 65 local jobs during commercial operations.

Energy firm EnBW has been given the go-ahead to start work on a pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) project in Germany. The Baden-Württemberg-headquartered firm will invest EUR280 million (US\$300 million) in upgrading the Rudolf Fettweis hydropower plant in Forbach into a modern PHES plant.

The HyBalance project is the pilot plant undertaking of Power2Hydrogen, a working group comprised of major industry players and academic research institutions aimed at demonstrating the large-scale potential for hydrogen from wind energy.
