

Cote d'Ivoire Energy Storage Project

Will a lithium-ion battery energy storage system be installed in Cote d'Ivoire?

A lithium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS) made by Saft will be installed at a 37.5MWp solar PV power plant in Cote d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast). It is the African country's first-ever large-scale solar project and the batteries will be used to smooth and integrate the variable output of the PV modules for export to the local electricity grid.

Why should Cote d'Ivoire invest in a solar power plant?

The solar power plant is regarded as a model project for the expansion of solar energy in Cote d'Ivoire. It is an important contribution to the fight against climate change and a decisive step towards increasing the share of renewable energies in the country's electricity supply to 45% by 2030.

Where is the first solar power plant in Cote d'Ivoire?

In Boundiali in the north of Cote d'Ivoire, the country's first solar power plant has now been inaugurated by Ivorian Prime Minister Beugre; Mamboury; and German Parliamentary State Secretary Bärbel Kofler. The power plant has already been providing up to 37 megawatts of power since June 2023.

Why did KfW build a solar power plant in Cote d'Ivoire?

"We also endeavoured to create employment for the local population," emphasises KfW Project Manager Clara Winkler-Tomety. During the construction phase, 75% of the workers came from the region. The new solar power plant in Cote d'Ivoire is helping to achieve the goals of German development cooperation in the expansion of renewable energies.

How much money does Cote d'Ivoire get from KfW Development Bank?

KfW Development Bank is financing the project with EUR 37 million, including a loan of EUR 27 million on behalf of the German Federal Government and a grant of EUR 10 million on behalf of the European Union. Cote d'Ivoire is contributing five million euros from its own budget.

The Boundiali solar PV plant is built at a cost of EUR40 million, and the financing agreements were signed in 2019. The solar project is financed by a concessional loan of EUR27 million from the German development bank KfW and a grant of EUR9.7 million from the European Union (EU). The Ivorian state contributed the remaining sum to reach the necessary financing.

Plans for future LNG supply to Cote d'Ivoire are materialized by the creation of the Cote d'Ivoire LNG consortium led by Total, which has been awarded a 3 million tons regasification project in 2016. In the model, primary supply of natural gas can then be extended if needed using LNG imports as a technical option.

IPP Greenergy and electric vehicle (EV) and battery energy storage system (BESS) firm BYD have extended a supply agreement for the Oasis de Atacama project in Chile, which they claim will have the world's largest BESS, to 3GWh.

The 50MW project will support Cote d'Ivoire's clean energy ambitions by generating more than 85GWh of clean energy per year, enough power for around 350,000 people. At a total investment of around \$60 million, the project is being fully developed by AMEA Power under a Build-Own-Operate and Transfer (BOOT) model.
