longhair,one lithium polymer cell (single unit of voltage source) is 3.7V. Two of them connected in series (2S) would give 7.4V. Two of them connected in parallel would give 3.7V but double the capacity (if each individual cell is the same.) A 2S2P battery (a battery is more than one cell) is made up of four cells in series/parallel configuration.

How many volts does a 2S LiPo battery have?

When two cells are connected in series,their voltages combine. Thus,a 2S LiPo battery has a nominal voltage of 7.4 volts(3.7V +3.7V). However,when fully charged,each cell can reach up to 4.2 volts,making the total voltage of a fully charged 2S battery 8.4. Conversely,the voltage can drop to 6.0 volts (3.0V per cell) when fully discharged.

The nominal cell voltage for a nickel-based battery is 1.2V, alkaline is 1.5V; silver-oxide is 1.6V and lead acid is 2.0V. Primary lithium batteries range between 3.0V and 3.9V. Li-ion is 3.6V; Li-phosphate is 3.2V and Li-titanate is 2.4V. Li-manganese and other lithium-based systems often use cell voltages of 3.7V and higher.
