So, how to install solar panels on roof? The detailed steps are given below, take a look. The first step in the solar panel installation guide is to install the mounts that will support the solar panels. These come in three primary types: pole, roof-ground, and flush mounts.

The solar panels that are used on a flat roof are exactly the same as the ones used on a pitched roof. You can technically lay the panels down on a flat roof - just as you would on a pitched roof - but this will restrict them from absorbing as much sun as possible, and might also lead to water damage.

Perhaps surprisingly, green roofs are actually well suited for PV - together they make up a biosolar roof. The

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solar panels do need to be installed at the same time as the green roof, however, since the mount is fitted underneath the growing medium to weigh it down. On the plus side, the transpiring vegetation keeps the panels well ventilated.

An in-roof solar system offers the exact opposite. In this system, the panels are installed as part of the roof with the panels mounted on the roof battens in place of tiles. This allows them to sit flush and blend in seamlessly with the roof, as well as not contribute a notable amount of additional weight to the structure.
