What happens if a rooftop solar system generates more electricity?

For best performance, panels should be cleaned periodically to remove dirt and other debris such as leaves. Panels will stay clean for a long time in areas with high rainfall and better air quality. You may need to pay a contractor to do this work if your roof is difficult to access and/or steep. Trees that shade your panels should be trimmed.

You will need to assess your property for its suitability for solar panels. Your panels need to face north to get the best power production. Your roof will ideally be north-east to north-west-facing, with a 15 to 45° pitch. Contact a solar company to assess your property for solar viability.

How reliable are solar panels? The reliability and lifespan of solar panels is excellent, according to a recent study by NREL. The researchers looked at 54,500 panels installed between 2000 and 2015.
