How does Photovoltaic Glass work?

It uses Photovoltaic glass. Photovoltaic glass (PV glass) is a technology that enables the conversion of light into electricity. Is Photovoltaic Glass a green energy source?

Photovoltaic glass is not perfectly transparent but allows some of the available light through. Is photovoltaic glass transparent?

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A solar module comprises six components, but arguably the most important one is the photovoltaic cell, which generates electricity. The conversion of sunlight, made up of particles called photons, into electrical energy by a solar cell is called the 'photovoltaic effect' - hence why we refer to solar cells as 'photovoltaic', or PV for short.
