How many batteries should be in a pack?

N. Under Packing Instructions 966 and 969, it states that "The maximum number of batteries in each package must be the minimum number required to power the equipment, plus two spare sets. A "set" of cells or batteries is the number of individual cells or batteries that are required to power each piece of equipment".

How many batteries can I keep in a box?

There are no restrictions on the number of batteries you can keep in each box. Stricter regulations from International Air Transport Association (IATA) apply to ship batteries by air as there are increased risks in the event of a fire. We, therefore, generally advise NOT shipping batteries in unaccompanied luggage by air freight.

How many spare batteries can I carry?

Yes, there are restrictions on the number of spare (uninstalled) lithium batteries you can carry. For most devices with batteries under 100 watt-hours, there is no limit to the number of devices or batteries you can carry in your carry-on. However, for larger batteries (100-300 watt-hours), you are typically limited to two spare batteries.

Can You Send batteries in a shipping container?

The following regulations apply when you are relocating possessions, including batteries, in a shipping container. This also includes a shared shipping container - often referred to as groupage. When you need to send regular lithium metal batteries such as AA or AAA batteries, you need to send them in a hard plastic casing.

Is it important to ship batteries safely?

With the growing demand for batteries, it's crucial to ship them safely and efficiently. You can't just toss lithium batteries in a box and call it a day. Transporting batteries is a serious business.

How do you package a battery?

Cells and batteries must be packaged in accordance with the requirements listed in 49 CFR 173.24, 173.24a and 173.185. UN specification packaging (POP) is encouraged but not required. The batteries must be placed in inner packaging designed to prevent damage, short circuits and movement within the outer package.

Also, prototype lithium batteries have special packaging requirements. Lithium prototype battery pack shipping container class 9 hazardous. To ship batteries, workers will need to have International Air Transport Association certification when a manufacturer plans to ship the batteries over air. Lithium ion batteries with a nominal capacity exceeding 100 Wh and lithium metal batteries containing over 2g of lithium are classed as dangerous goods (Class 9), as such there are strict requirements for transporting them via road, air, sea and rail. Simplified requirements apply for other lithium batteries that do not reach these thresholds.
