What is the first coal-fired power plant in the UAE?

Does Dubai need a power plant?

The power plant is estimated to supply Dubai with 20% of its total power needs. It will also help avoid about 30 million tonnes of carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions by 2030. The Hassyan power plant was developed on a build-own-operate (BOO) basis using the independent power producer (IPP) model.

How much power will Dubai's Hassyan power plant generate?

The 2.4GW power plant is expected to generate enough electricity to power approximately 250,000 households and expand Dubai's current grid capacity by 25%. The Hassyan power plant will comprise four ultra-supercritical coal-fired generating units of 600MW capacity each.

When will Dubai's new power plant come online?

The four units are expected to come online in 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023, respectively. The power plant will be owned and operated by Hassyan Energy Company, a joint venture between Dubai Electricity and Water Authority (DEWA, 51%) and the consortium of ACWA Power, Harbin Electric, and the Silk Road Fund (jointly 49%).

How will a nuclear power plant affect the UAE?

The 1,400-megawatt unit, when operational, will add a total of 5,600 gigawatts to the UAE grid. The added nuclear power brings the Gulf oil producer closer to realizing its goal of burning less fossil fuels for domestic consumption.
