Most Indian PV exports are to the US, which accounted for 97% and 99% of India's PV exports in FY2023 and FY2024, respectively. India also exports PV products to South Africa, Somalia, Kenya, the UAE, Afghanistan, Nepal and Bangladesh. The US has imposed steep tariffs on PV products from China to gradually phase out Chinese imports.

Regionally, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa all saw rising import volumes, while the Americas showed a slight decline, and the Asia-Pacific witnessed a significant downturn. Europe Excluding the Netherlands, Europe's largest shipping hub, Spain ranked second among individual countries for Chinese module imports in 2024.

The Middle East imported 1.18 GW of modules from China in January 2025, down 60% YoY from 2.95 GW, and 1.32 GW in February, down 29% YoY from 1.85 GW. By the end of February, cumulative module shipments to the Middle East totaled 2.49 GW, down 48% YoY from 4.8 GW. The Middle East was the only region to see module import growth in February ...

By the end of May 2024, total exports of PV modules this year totaled \$13.62 billion, or about 97.9 GW. From the country distribution point of view, the Netherlands, Brazil, Saudi Arabia and other countries continue to lead the PV module export market, in May the export volume of these three countries are more than 1GW.

As a result, the country imported over 1 GW of modules so far this year, establishing itself as a key player in PV development within the African market. Overall, China's module exports surpassed expectations in January and February, and reached a new peak in March, driving the total export volume in the first quarter to over 50 GW.

The EU was the biggest destination region for the Chinese mainland's PV exports in 2022, buying nearly \$23 billion worth of products, up 113 percent year-on-year. This is equivalent to about 84 GW of modules, more than half of China's total module exports in 2022, he said.

With limited local production, Brazil's tax-free import quotas will have minimal impact on Chinese module imports in the short term. The Middle East and Africa.
