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The Romanian and Bulgarian governments launched their first round of BESS project bidding in February and March 2024, with project scale reaching 240 MW/480 MWh and 350 MW respectively. In the European energy storage market, Eastern European countries started later than their Western European counterparts.

Panelists at this year's Energy Storage Summit Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) in September described Hungary's scheme as one of the most advanced in the world. Grant support for energy storage in the EU has also been activated via a separate scheme, the post-Covid-19 Recovery and Resilience Plan, including in Romania, Finland and Greece.

On 1 October 2022, the Energy Community adopted the Gas Storage Regulation (EU/2022/1032), requiring its non-EU countries to fill up their gas storages to the same levels as in the EU and certify storage operators.
