Ecuador's government has recently committed to the Ecological Transition through which it aims to reach carbon neutrality by 2050, and for this, fossil fuel base generation will need to be displaced. Although hydropower generation helped diversify Ecuador's electricity matrix, the country remains highly vulnerable to climate change, as 68% of its hydro capacity is run-of-river.

Ecuador suffered one of its worst energy-related environmental disasters in April 2020, when a pair of ruptured pipelines spilled 672,000 gallons of petroleum products into the Coca and Napo Rivers, affecting food and water supplies for 105 communities in the Ecuadorian Amazon and prompting ongoing protests.
