

Energy storage project implemented in Manchester UK

Will a UK battery energy storage project come online next year?

One of UK's largest battery energy storage projects has changed hands and will come online next year as part of a low carbon energy park in Greater Manchester. UK-based developer Statera Energy has acquired a 680 MW/1360 MWh battery energy storage project in Greater Manchester from Carlton Power.

Who owns Carlton power's 'Carrington storage' project in Greater Manchester?

UK-based developer Statera Energy has acquired a 680 MW/1360 MWh battery energy storage project in Greater Manchester from Carlton Power. Located at Trafford Low Carbon Energy Park, Carrington Storage is expected to become one of the largest of its kind in Europe once fully energised in 2026.

What is Carlton power's £300m liquid air energy storage project?

Carlton Power, the UK energy infrastructure development company, is pleased to announce that Highview Power's £300m liquid air energy storage (LAES) project will be the first energy scheme to be built on its Trafford Low Carbon Energy Park, at Carrington, eight miles south of Manchester.

Will Carlton power build a 1GW battery energy storage scheme in Manchester?

Carlton Power secures planning permission for a 1GW battery energy storage scheme in Manchester, aiming for commercial operation in 2025. The project will strengthen regional energy security and surpass the current largest BESS in the world.

Is Manchester energy planning a large-scale 5mw/15mwh project?

The company has had a smaller-scale 5MW/15MWh project operational, also in Manchester, since 2018. It first revealed plans for a large-scale project in Carrington in 2019 which the then-CEO told Energy-Storage.news would start construction the following year.

Who owns Trafford low carbon energy park?

The c12 hectare Trafford Low Carbon Energy Park is wholly owned by Carlton Power. Highview Power announced on June 13th that it had secured a £300m investment to build its first commercial-scale LAES plant: from the UK Infrastructure Bank, Centrica and a syndicate of financial investors.

The 1GW (1040MW / 2080MWh) project will be located at the Trafford Low Carbon Energy Park in Greater Manchester.

By Scott Poulter. The UK is known to be one of the world's most active markets for battery energy storage. In 2022, the market saw a record 800 MWh of new storage capacity being added. This took the UK's operational energy storage capacity to 2.4 GW and 2.6 GWh, spread across more than 160 sites.
