

Energy storage system in Antwerp Belgium

What is the largest European battery-based energy storage project?

In May 2023, we launched our largest European battery-based energy storage project at the Antwerp platform in Belgium. With its 40 containers, the site will develop a capacity of 75 MWh, which is equivalent to the daily consumption of almost 10,000 homes.

Is TotalEnergies developing a second battery storage project in Belgium?

The new project will be developed on the site of TotalEnergies' depot in Feluy.

How many MW / 150 MWh will TotalEnergies store in Belgium?

These two projects, which represent a global investment of nearly EUR70 million, will bring TotalEnergies' storage capacity in Belgium to 50 MW/150 MWh. In July 2024, we signed the final investment decision for a 100 MW/200 MWh battery electricity storage project in Dahlem.

How much power does TotalEnergies have in Belgium?

It will have a power rating of 25 MW and capacity of 75 MWh, thanks to the forty "Intensium Max High Energy" lithium-ion containers supplied by Saft. These two projects, which represent a global investment of nearly EUR70 million, will bring TotalEnergies' storage capacity in Belgium to 50 MW / 150 MWh.

What is the largest battery-based energy storage site in France?

Featuring 27 containers, each with a storage capacity of 2.5 MWh, it can maintain power for over 200,000 homes for one hour. With a total storage capacity of 61 MWh, this is the largest battery-based energy storage site in France. The battery-based ESS facility at the Carling platform came on stream in May 2022 and comprises 11 battery containers.

When will TotalEnergies start-up in Belgium?

Start-up is expected at the end of 2025. These two projects, which represent a global investment of nearly EUR70 million, will bring TotalEnergies' storage capacity in Belgium to 50 MW / 150 MWh.
