

Estonia's special energy storage battery

What type of energy is used in Estonia?

Renewable energy here is the sum of hydropower, wind, solar, geothermal, modern biomass and wave and tidal energy. Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important energy source in lower-income settings. What is a residential energy storage system?

The residential energy storage system comes with a rated voltage of 48V, and an operating voltage range from 40V to 60V. It achieves a depth of discharge of 90%. Its maximum charge/discharge rate is 210A. The battery delivers more 4,000 charge-discharge cycles.
