The company, which is 30% owned by the French oil company Total Energies, has just signed a preliminary agreement with Alain-Claude Bilie By Nze, Gabon's Minister of Energy and Water Resources. The agreement concerns the construction of a 50 MWp solar photovoltaic power plant near the capital Libreville.

The 8 solar power plants we will build will save one million litres of fuel oil per year, or 2600 tonnes of CO₂, and reduce production costs by 30% stalled near isolated villages, they will supply nearly 1600 homes. With plans to expand from 11 MW to 30 MW, the plant will reduce fossil fuel dependence and provide clean energy to over 300,000 homes.

The future solar power plant will thus increase Gabon's installed capacity while providing clean energy to households in the provinces of Woleu-Ntem and Ogooué-Ivindo, and its industries. Anea Power, which has eyes on the Gabonese renewable energy market, has already completed several solar projects in sub-Saharan Africa.
