



# How big should the home solar light be

How big should a solar system be?

The amount of available sunny roof area can often be a limiting factor when deciding what system size to install, particularly for household solar systems in urban areas. One residential solar panel is often around 1.7 m<sup>2</sup> in area. A common 6.6 kW system might take up 29 - 32 m<sup>2</sup> of roof space, depending upon the rated capacity of the panels.

What size solar panel do I Need?

The size of the solar panel you need will depend on a few factors, including the wattage of the lights and the average amount of sunlight your location receives. A general rule of thumb is that you'll need one watt of solar power for every hour that you want to run your lights.

How much space does a solar panel take up?

One residential solar panel is often around 1.7 m<sup>2</sup> in area. A common 6.6 kW system might take up 29 - 32 m<sup>2</sup> of roof space, depending upon the rated capacity of the panels. Panels can be installed in portrait or landscape orientation to make the best use of the available roof space.

How can I calculate the size of my solar system?

To calculate your solar system size, divide your solar system's daily energy production by your location's average daily peak sun hours. This will give you an estimate in kilowatts (kW). For example, if you have 4 peak sun hours, your calculation would be:  $6 / 4 = 1.5$  kW. Then, multiply your solar system size by 1.2 to cover system inefficiencies.

What size battery do I need for my solar system?

To determine the size of the battery you need for your solar system, you'll need to calculate the storage capacity based on your energy usage and desired autonomy. If we repeat the calculations with a lead acid battery, we'll need a storage capacity of 99.6 kWh (33.3 kWh x 3 days of autonomy). How do I size my solar PV system?

You can't correctly size your solar PV system unless you know how much electricity your home uses now (and how much you might be using in the future). Step Two: Get Everything in Place. The second step is getting everything in place. Find a sunny spot to place our solar light in. A solar light does not need direct sunlight but it does need to be in an area where it will get full sunlight for a good part of the day.. If you are using a stake or bracket, make sure to hammer it into the ground firmly so that it won't move.
