It is not possible to integrate them into an existing roof, so they usually have to be installed in the roof of a new build or where the roof is being completely replaced for some reason. A solar roof, or solar roof system, consists of an array of electricity-generating photovoltaic panels or films installed on the roof of a building, whether this is pitched or flat. Among the components of a solar roof installation are the photovoltaic modules themselves, mounting systems, and cables that connect the system to the power grid.

Roof installed solar panels are becoming increasingly common as the "Green" movement and renewable energy advance in an attempt to minimize carbon emissions, provide better air quality, and lower energy costs. As a result, homeowners and commercial developers are becoming more likely to use photovoltaic panels (solar panels) on their roofs.

The LEE-TISO testing centre for PV components at the University of Applied Sciences of Southern Switzerland installed Europe's first grid-connected PV plant, a 10kW roof, in May 1982. When the panels were tested in 2002, the average peak output of the panels was only 11% lower than the nominal value in 1982.
