How long does it take to charge a 12V battery?

For a 50Ah battery: 1A takes 60h, 2A takes 30h, 4A takes 15h, 6A takes 10h, 8A takes 7.5h, and 10A takes 6h. These are rough estimates and may vary.

How much current do you need to charge a 12V battery?
