The UPS battery backup time can be estimated using the formula:
$$\text{Backup Time (hours)} = \frac{\text{Battery Capacity (Ah)} \times \text{System Voltage (V)}}{\text{Power Load (W)}}$$
 Backup Time (hours) = Power Load (W) Battery Capacity (Ah) ÷ System Voltage (V)

The ratio of watts to VA is called the "power factor" and is expressed either as a number (i.e. - 0.8) or a percentage (i.e. - 80%). When sizing a UPS for your specific requirements, the power factor matters most. Generally, your UPS should have an Output Watt Capacity 20-25% higher than the total power drawn by any

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attached equipment.
