How many Watts Does a solar LED street light use?

Now the solar led street light source uses led lamp beads, the number of led watts is different from the traditional high-pressure sodium lamp wattage, such as high-pressure sodium lamp 100w, equivalent to led36w, 150w equivalent to led60w and so on.

How to choose solar street light?

The higher the luminous efficiency,the better the energy-saving effect. It is also one of the most important indicators for choosing solar street light. However,this is not clearly specified in the LED standard,so it must be carefully confirmed when purchasing solar street light.

Why do we need solar street light?

Solar street light is now seen more and more on the road,the main reason is that it is green,low-carbon and environmentally friendly,with low power consumption,high luminous efficiency and long service life. So now the upgrade of municipal road street lights will consider solar street light first.

How to determine the distance of a street light?

The distance of the street light is determined by the power of the street led fixture , the street light installation height , the width of the street , lux level desire .

What is a street LED light interval?

In general,the street led light interval is related to the hights of the light pole and power of the LED street light . 60 watts of LED street light ,6 meters hight of light poles,and interval is 15-18 meters; 8 meters hight of the pole have distance at 20-24 meters ,32-36 meters distance of 12-meter light pole . It's for reference only.

What is the spacing of led road light?

The spacing of the led road light is also related with the nature of the road , such as industrial zone road, rural roads , urban roads , and highway , as different roads will need different hight light poles and different lux level .

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On average, a 35-watt street light operating for approximately 4,000 hours a year (typical for street lighting) will consume around 140 kWh (kilowatt-hours) annually. ... Another alternative is solar-powered street lights, which use energy from the sun to operate. These systems include solar panels, batteries, and LED lights. ...

A 300 watt Light, which happens to be our NextGen II 300 watt, at 30 feet high looks like this. The numbers in the circles is footcandles. See the footcandle video page for that. 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Per year power consumption: $3 * 24 * 365 = 26280$ Watts. + 10% of loss = $26280 + 2628 = 28908$ Watts hour.
9 watt led bulb power consumption: Hourly consumption: 9 Watts per hour, Day Power consumption: $9 * 24 = 216$ W/H. Yearly power consumption = $9 * 24 * 365 + 10\%$ power loss = $78840 + 7884 = 86724$ Watts hour.
Converting into units 86.7 units per year.

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
