How many watts is a 60 watt LED bulb?

A 60-watt LED equivalent is 7-9 watts. A 100-watt incandescent bulb produces 1600 lumens of light, while a 12-14 watt LED gives off the same. A 150-watt incandescent bulb produces 2600 lumens of light, while an 18-23 watt LED gives off the equivalent. An LED bulb uses approximately 85% less energy than a halogen bulb.

How much energy does a 60 watt bulb use?

A 60-watt bulb consumes 60 watts of energy. Since we used 60-watt incandescent bulbs for so many years, we associated a certain level of brightness with 60 watts. But we can't do that anymore, since LED technology produces more light while using fewer watts. Instead, we need to use lumens. A lumen is a measure of visible light energy.

How many lumens does a 9 watt LED bulb produce?

From the table, a 9-watt incandescent bulb is equivalent to a 1-watt LED bulb. A 60-watt LED equivalent is 7-9 watts. For example, you can use a 9 watt LED bulb in a bulb that originally used 25 watts; you can even use a 9 watt LED bulb in a 60-watt lamp. How bright is 9 watt LED bulb? 9W LED (800 lumens) replaces 60W bulb or 14W CFL. At the same time, it's a very bright bulb, maybe between 75 and 100 watts - less than 10% energy
