What is a typical power supply voltage?

The voltage can range but is typically between service voltages of 240 & 600 Volts (excluding large commercial buildings shown above which "step down" the voltage onsite). This solves for the voltage component of the power equation, but what about Amps?

What does a DC power supply spec mean?

The stability specification of a DC power supply refers to its ability to remain stable during DC load changes. This measurement is taken as the amount of current change in relation to a drop in voltage (it is very often at 1% or better). High-quality power supplies will have very little ripples.

How many devices can be operated from a single power supply?

Unlimited devices can be operated from a single power supply as long as continuous power consumption does not exceed 94W (3.8A). Industrial enclosures can come with a variety of ratings that typically specify protection against particulates, water and other contaminants.
