How much power does a solar generator need?

For outdoor and camping purposes, you only need smaller, handheld solar generators, which are usually in the 150W-350W range. These solar generators do not have the power to match larger power stations, but they are not meant to run appliances in emergency situations.

What does wattage mean on a solar generator?

The wattage indicates the amount of power used in energy transfer on a solar generator. A generator with a greater capacity (i.e., more watts) can provide more power in a single charge. However, it's essential to understand that power transfer doesn't always occur at an even rate.

How much battery does a solar generator use?

Some solar generators can use 100% of their battery, but others don't in order to protect and prolong the battery. The ideal balance is about an 80% DoD before recharging. Inverter efficiency (typically 85%): The inverter consumes power from the battery while it converts DC to AC power. In most cases, you can expect 85% efficiency.

How to calculate the power output of a solar generator?

To calculate the required power output of a solar generator, multiply your total wattage needs by the number of days you will use the generator. The result is the power output you need from a solar generator. Note that this total is only for running your devices. You have to increase the generator power (doubling is recommended) so it can charge while running your devices.
