What size inverter do I Need?

The size of the inverter you need depends on the total wattage of all devices you plan to power simultaneously. Sum the wattages of your appliances, add a 20-25% safety margin, and choose an inverter with at least this capacity. A 3000-5000 watt inverter is usually sufficient for an average household. For example, if your total running wattage is 2200W and your surge wattage adds another 400W, your total power requirement is 2600W. Inverters typically operate at an efficiency of around 85%-95%. To ensure your inverter can handle your total load, divide your total power consumption by the inverter's efficiency.
