



How much does a household LED solar light cost

How much can you save per year by using LED lighting?

According to energy.gov, the average household saves about \$225 in energy costs per year by using LED lighting. 1. LED lights are much more efficient than other lighting options, like CFLs and incandescent bulbs.

How much does a solar light cost?

These lights reside off the main power grid and can be installed in remote locations. Because of the advanced technology required for solar lights, they are more expensive, averaging about \$3000 per light. That includes the light fixture, the solar panel, controller, pole, and the smaller components that make up the light.

How much do solar street lights cost?

When comparing the total costs of traditional and solar lighting, there appears to be a clear winner. Overall, solar street lights cost around \$4,800 over 5 years, while standard costs a steep \$8,800 because of trenching and installation costs. As before, this is the cost of one street light.

How much does electricity cost to install lights?

Meaning if you had the national average electricity rate of \$0.10 per kWh, you would spend \$36.50 per year on electricity for lighting. This gives you a savings of \$178.50 from the existing lights--over \$6,000 throughout the course of home ownership--just from just the electricity savings.

How much does a light bulb cost?

Using the process above (with the assumption that all of the light bulbs in the home are CFLs), the average yearly electricity cost of lighting would be \$51.10. Take a look at our guide to LEDs for more information. Existing light bulbs, called incandescents, last for 1,200 hours on average.

How much money can you save by switching to LED lights?

By switching to LEDs, you can save around \$4,000 over 20 years (the typical lifespan of an LED). As far as energy efficiency projects go, that's a lot! To put that in perspective, consider that switching to a heat pump water heater (another great savings opportunity) will save you about \$200 per year and \$5,000 over its 15-20 year lifespan.

Note that the values presented below are approximations based on 8 hours of daily usage and an electricity rate of \$0.16/kWh (this rate varies from state to state, so be sure to take that into account), and average kWh usage per month.

Using an LED light bulb for 2 hours per day will use about 0.61 kilowatt-hours of electricity per month and 7.3 kilowatt-hours of electricity per year. An incandescent light bulb costs an average of \$0.52 to use for a month and \$6.22 to use for a year. An LED light bulb costs an average of \$0.09 to use for a month and \$1.04 to use for a year.
