Yes, you can convert 110v to 220v. In most cases, the existing circuitry of a site needs to be upgraded by an electrician to do so. But, when you use a 110v to 220v step-up converter, you can install it DIY. What uses more electricity 220 or 110? When 220v wiring is used, less current is required than with 110v wiring. Power is measured in watts.
