How much does a solar system cost per watt?

A solar installation's "cost per watt" is a little like the "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. Expect the cost per watt to be between \$2 to \$3. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Solar panels typically pay for themselves within 5 to 15 years.

How much does a solar panel cost?

Today's premium monocrystalline solar panels typically cost between 30 and 50 cents per Watt, putting the price of a single 400-watt solar panel between \$120 to \$200 depending on how you buy it. Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.25 per Watt. The cost of a solar panel also depends on how you buy it.

How much does a commercial solar system cost?

Commercial solar installations are a great way for companies to lower energy costs. Generally, installing solar panels on businesses costs a bit less per watt because the systems are larger, but the total costs will be higher. In 2025, the average cost for commercial solar panels is just about \$2.00 per watt.

According to the Solar Energy Industries Association, the average price per watt for residential solar projects was \$3.27 in the first half of 2023. For example, the PPW of a 5,500 Watt system looks quite different before and after accounting for the 30% tax credit.

How do you calculate wattage of a solar system?

To calculate the wattage of a solar system, you divide the cost of the system (in dollars) by the size of the system (in watts). $PPW = \text{System cost} / \text{System wattage}$. Since solar systems are typically sized in kilowatts (kW), you'll have to multiply by 1,000 to convert to watts. For example, a 5.5 kW solar system is equivalent to a 5,500 Watt solar system.

Price of Solar Panels. Solar panels cost \$0.70 to \$1.50 per watt on average but can run from \$0.30 to \$2.20 per watt. A typical 250 watt panel costs \$175 to \$375 on average. For an entire solar system, the average homeowner pays \$3,910 to \$6,490. Panels can cost as low as \$1,890 and as high as \$13,600.. This price depends on several factors:

Based on 2022 average labor rates, solar panel installation cost accounts for roughly 5.5% of the total cost of a solar project, according to the National Renewable Energy Lab (NREL). To put that in perspective, using the modeled market price (MMP) of \$2.95 per Watt for residential solar, labor costs contributed just 16 cents per Watt of ...

The best way to understand and compare estimates between different installers is to determine how much your solar panel system will cost per watt (\$/W). You can do this by taking the total dollar cost of your solar panel system, subtracting out any included battery costs, and dividing it by the number of watts (kW x 1000).
