

How much power can an outdoor power supply connect to

How much power can a Philips Hue outdoor power supply withstand?

The bottom line is that the maximum power is a little more than 70 watts, much more than the 40 watt power supply from Philips Hue should be able to withstand. But with a measuring device I was able to make interesting findings. The outdoor power supply seems to have enough reserves.

What is the recommended electrical supply for garden buildings?

We would always recommend a 32A 30mA RCD Protected Supply for our garden buildings. There are two aspects that you need to consider: The wiring and installation of sockets and switches within the building. Getting the supply of electricity from the house/property to the garden building itself.

Where should an outdoor socket be installed?

In fact it is wise to have one at the back and one at the front of the property, which can be used for car washing equipment, power washers and other items such as vacuum cleaners. In this DIY guide we go through the steps involved in how an outdoor socket is installed.

What type of cable do I need for my garden building?

For your garden building's electricity supply, we recommend a 6mm SWA Cable. This size is typically sufficient for most cable runs, but the length may affect the choice. Additionally, ensure you have a 32A 30mA RCD Protected Supply.

Can I install power from my house to my garden building?

Unfortunately, we do not offer a service to install power from your house to the garden building. This needs to be arranged with a qualified electrician. However, it's not essential to have this done before installing the building. So, how do I get the electricity running to my garden building?

Why do you need an exterior socket?

Correctly installed, an exterior socket is a very useful facility to have. It means you no longer have to run extension leads from inside the house, with the potential for tripping over them! It enables you to run electric garden equipment such as a lawn mower, hedge trimmer and various other items including power tools, in a far safer way.

If you're wondering "how much does an outdoor socket cost?" then you'll need to work out two costs; the materials and the labour. Extension cords have an amp limit. You need to ensure the cable and the wall socket can handle all the equipment you plan to use at the same time. Overloading this can damage the cable and wall socket, and potentially cause a fire hazard. It only provides mains power, so you can only use items with a standard 3-pin plug.

However, you might be able to supply an outdoor power point from a socket in an attached garage, as long as this isn't already on a spur. How to fit an external socket. ... Leave the conduit protruding, and enough cable to connect to the new socket. After that, remove the central knock-out from the box and fit a weatherproof grommet.
