



How much power should I buy when buying an inverter

How much power does an inverter use?

Most inverters have an efficiency of between 60% and 80%. This efficiency can also be referred to as the power factor of an inverter. For our calculations, we would use a power factor of 0.8. Hence, Power supplied (or VA rating of the inverter) = Power consumed by equipment in watts / Power factor

What factors should you consider when buying an inverter?

Here are 12 key factors to consider when you buy an inverter: Inverter or Inverter/Charger - Both inverters and inverter/chargers provide current from stored battery power, but only inverter/chargers connect to AC sources, pass AC through to equipment, recharge batteries and automatically switch to battery power when AC power is unavailable.

Can an inverter run a house comfortably?

An inverter can store electricity in the batteries as DC power and switch to the main power line of your house if there the power fails, and it turns the DC power to AC for our home. How to choose a home inverter?

There is no rocket science in selecting the inverter for home. To understand the inverter capacity for home, just list down the appliances you wish to operate on inverter power. Suppose you plan to connect 2 tube lights (60 Watts), 1 fan (70 Watts) and 2 CFLs (40 Watts). In this scenario, your total power requirement will be:

Do I need a bigger inverter?

If you want to power up more appliances, you will need a bigger inverter. To calculate or determine what size inverter can meet your energy requirements, you need to calculate the total power of all the appliances you want to run with the inverter. Here is how you can do it.

What is the VA rating of an inverter?

Generally, the VA rating of an inverter should be slightly higher than your total power requirement in watts. This ensures the inverter runs efficiently and isn't overloaded. Power Factor is the ratio of the power required by equipment to the power supplied by the inverter. The average power factor of inverters is 0.7 or 0.8.
