Is PSA Mumbai a 100% renewable container terminal?

PSA Mumbai, part of the international port operating group PSA, has achieved a major milestone in its emissions reduction journey by becoming India's first 100% renewable powered container terminal on the commissioning of its 7.8MW solar farm with O2 Power.

What is Bharat Mumbai container terminals (BMCT)?

Bharat Mumbai Container Terminals (BMCT), operated by Singapore's PSA International at Jawaharlal Nehru Port, announced its status as India's inaugural container terminal fully powered by renewable energy. This achievement is attributed to a 7.8 MW solar farm collaboration with O2 Power.

How long is a berth at PSA Mumbai?

When fully completed, the terminal will have a berth length of 2,000 meters. PSA Mumbai has become India's first 100% renewable powered container terminal on the commissioning of its 7.8MW solar farm with O2 Power.

What is PSA Mumbai's New solar farm?

The solar farm, which will be expanded to 10MW by June 2024, will provide over 75% of PSA Mumbai's electricity requirements with the remaining renewable power sourced from Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (MSEDCL) and other providers.

This 2030 deployment target should provide reliable demand for domestically produced solar PV modules, especially with India's Approved List of Models and Manufacturers (ALMM) requiring government and government-assisted projects -- which represent about 70 percent of India's module demand -- to source India-made solar PV modules.
