Will China build a lithium-ion battery plant in Indonesia?

China's REPT Battero has revealed plans to build a lithium-ion battery plant in Indonesia, targeting 8 GWh of annual production capacity in the first phase. From ESS News Hong Kong-listed REPT Battero has announced plans to invest in a new battery production facility in Indonesia.

Why is Hyundai launching a battery plant in Indonesia?

Hyundai and LG Energy Solution have opened a \$1.1bn battery cell plant in Indonesia as the south-east Asian country works to build an electric vehicle ecosystem. The launch of the country's first battery plant on Wednesday is part of Indonesia's push to move up the global EV supply chain.

Rept Battero's non-wholly-owned subsidiary, PT Rept Battero Indonesia, will invest in and construct the Indonesian Battery Factory.

How many GWh will Indonesia's battery factory produce?

The first phase of the Indonesian battery factory is expected to achieve an annual production capacity of 8 GWh of lithium-ion batteries and components. Hong Kong-listed REPT Battero has announced plans to invest in a new battery production facility in Indonesia.

Is battery storage taking off in Indonesia?

Despite the opportunities for manufacturing, from a deployment perspective, battery storage has not yet taken off in Indonesia beyond a handful of projects, including a 5MW pilot announced by the government in March 2022. Rept Battero has announced plans to develop an 8GWh gigafactory in Indonesia specialising in lithium-ion cells for BESS.

Why is Indonesia launching its first EV battery plant?

The launch of the country's first battery plant on Wednesday is part of Indonesia's push to move up the global EV supply chain. Indonesia has the world's largest reserves of nickel, a crucial component in EV batteries and steelmaking.

The Indonesian plant will supply various anode materials for electric vehicles, appliance batteries and energy storage systems. BTR claims to have held the largest global market share for anode materials for the past 14 years, supplying battery manufacturers such as Panasonic, Samsung SDI, LGES, SKOn, CALT, and BYD worldwide.

In February of this year, LBM also signed a long-term supply contract for lithium iron phosphate cathode materials with LG Energy Solution. The two parties agreed that from this year to 2028, LBM will sell a total of 160,000 tons of lithium iron phosphate cathode material products to LG Energy Solution, making LBM the first Chinese lithium iron phosphate material ...

Indonesia, in fact, establishes several project portfolios for the development of EV battery ecosystems and integrated battery energy storage systems. The government unveiled its first EV manufacturing plant, generated from a joint venture between South Korea's consortium and Indonesia Battery Corp (IBC).

The company is currently developing two much larger factories in the country, including an EV battery production plant in Michigan which is already under construction, and a split production plant in Illinois with annual production capacity of 10GWh of battery packs and 40GWh of lithium-ion battery cells aimed at both EV and ESS market segments.

The government-owned Indonesia Battery Corporation (IBC) is exploring opportunities to establish cell manufacturing and battery storage integration facilities with engineering company Citaglobal. IBC, also known as PT Industri Baterai Indonesia, was founded by four separate state-owned enterprises in the Southeast Asian country.
