How do you install an outdoor power socket?

How do you install an outdoor outlet?

Approaching the back of the outlet hole at a downward angle, drill through the exterior wall and siding until you reach the other side. The goal is to mark a spot for the exterior outlet just behind and below the indoor wall plug so there's enough space in the wall to add both electrical boxes back in at the end. 5. Where should a power outlet be located?

On my current outdoor cams I have 2 that run solely on solar, the outdoor cams use between 400ma (day) and 550ma (night) each camera.
