Do I need a travel adapter in Lisbon?

To ensure compatibility with the power sockets in Lisbon, it's recommended to carry a travel adapter. A travel adapter allows you to connect your devices with different plug types to the local power sockets.

Do I need a power adapter for Lisbon?

What type of power socket does Portugal use?

The answer is simple. Portugal uses Type F power sockets, which have two round pins and grounding clips. Your standard US devices with flat, two-pronged plugs won't fit directly into these outlets. To use your electronics, you'll need a Portugal adapter type that specifically converts US plugs to Type F.

Are there electrical outlets in Lisbon?

No, the electrical outlets in Lisbon are different from those in the United States. In Lisbon electrical outlets of types C & F are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Lisbon? The electrical outlets and power plugs in Lisbon are of types C & F (see images).

Do I need an adapter to use a charger in Lisbon?

Chargers for iPhones, Android phones and other smartphones or cell phones are usually dual voltage, so you can use them all over the world. However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Lisbon outlet. Lisbon uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C & F (see images).
