

Is it safe to install outdoor power supply in Belgium

What are the electrical regulations in Belgium?

It contains the standards to be respected during any installation of an electrical system. These regulations have been mandatory in Belgium since 1981. It concerns both the domestic electrical network (house, apartment,...) and the industrial electrical network (offices, factory,...).

Is there a Belgian electrical standard?

There is not a single Belgian electrical standard, there are several. What is the RGIE? RGIE is the general regulation for electrical installations in Belgium. It is everything that is legal about the standards to be respected for the installation of an electrical system.

What is the voltage of a plug & socket in Belgium?

Just like the rest of Europe, the voltage in Belgium is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Although the origin of the type E plug and socket system is unclear, it was likely developed in the 1920s by the Belgian electrical accessories manufacturer Vynckier (now part of General Electric Power Controls).

Why is my electrical installation non-compliant?

Your electrical installation will be declared non-compliant if it poses a risk to people's safety: the most common causes include no electrical diagram, no differential switch and cable insulation...

What if my electrical installation does not comply with safety standards?

If you discover that your electrical installation does not comply with safety standards, you have a period of 18 months after it was reported. But it is advisable to do it immediately because it can be dangerous. If you have poor insulation or a problem with your main breaker, a fire can happen quickly.
