What is the most recent export of Gabon?

The most recent exports of Gabon are led by Crude Petroleum (\$4.88B). During the last five reported years the exports of Gabon have changed by \$794M from \$7.08B in 2017 to \$7.88B in 2022.

Why should Gabon restructure its infrastructure?

Strengthening transport and energy infrastructure would be essential. Gabon's only railway, for example, was blocked for weeks due to landslides at end-December 2022, compromising shipments of wood and manganese as well as the supply of basic goods in affected areas.

What is the Gabon economic update?

What products does Gabon specialize in?

Gabon specializes in Manganese Ore (736), Veneer Sheets (168), Sawn Wood (21), Plywood (12), and Manganese Oxides (10.7). Specialization is measured using RCA, an index that takes the ratio between Gabon observed and expected exports in each product.

What are the main industries in Gabon?

It is estimated that 30 percent of the population had a monthly income below the guaranteed monthly minimum wage of \$143. Gabon's largest industries are petroleum, minerals (mostly manganese), and timber. The government plans to develop Gabon's agricultural sector and to improve its national infrastructure.

What are the exports of Gabon in 2022?

Further, the United Arab Emirates imposes anti-dumping duties on imports of certain goods, such as car batteries, ceramic and porcelain tiles, and hydraulic cement. The anti-dumping duty rates vary depending on the HS codes of the goods and country of export and/or origin. In some cases, the anti-dumping duty is 67.5% of the CIF value of the goods.
