Where does Kazakhstan's electricity come from?

Approximately 70% of Kazakhstan's electricity comes from this carbon-intensive fossil fuel, much of which is mined using outdated Soviet infrastructure. This accident came on the heels of a rather different event involving Kazakhstan's energy industry.

Should Kazakhstan adopt an energy security strategy?

Honda Fuel Cell Power Generator. Solar Power. The potential of solar energy in Kazakhstan is estimated at 2.5 billion kWh per year, which corresponds to an area of about 10 km² of solar cells with a total efficiency of 16%. The average efficiency of modern solar panels varies in the range of 15-25%.
