

Kazakhstan generators arrive at power station

How many power plants are there in Kazakhstan?

Electricity generation sector Electricity in Kazakhstan is generated by 222 power plants of various forms of ownership.

How much electricity is generated in Kazakhstan in 2021?

In total, in 2021, 114.3 billion kWh of electricity was generated at the country's power plants. The winter maximum load was recorded on January 21, 2022 and amounted to 15,931 MW. In 2021, 5,562 technological violations were committed in the Unified Electricity System of Kazakhstan.

How does Kazakhstan's coal-fired power plant work?

The agreement, signed in 2011, includes economic cooperation in the field of financing, design, construction, operation and maintenance of the power plant. The coal-fired plant will be Kazakhstan's first independent power producer (IPP) project, using foreign capital project financing for the construction and operation.

Does Kazakhstan have a unified power system?

Kazakhstan's unified power system operates in a normal mode, in parallel with the power systems of the Russian Federation and Central Asian countries. As of today, 220 power plants are operating in the country, including 144 RES facilities with a total capacity of 2.8 GW.

How to meet demand for electric capacity in Kazakhstan?

To meet demand for electric capacity, the electric capacity market attracts investments to maintain existing and commission new electric capacities in the unified power system (UPS) of Kazakhstan.

The growth in electricity generation in Kazakhstan, according to the Bureau of National Statistics of the Agency for Strategic Planning and Reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan, amounted to 2.5%. Calculations, according to the operational data of the Kazakhstan operator of the electricity and capacity market (KOREM), indicate a growth close to 2%.

One of Kazakhstan's power companies, Samruk-Energy JSC, was recently awarded a \$94 million loan from the Eurasian Development Bank to build Kazakhstan's largest wind farm. The project will produce 172 million kilowatt/hours of electrical energy per year, save more than 60 million tons of coal, and reduce emissions of greenhouse gases. ...

At the end of 2019, Kazakhstan had 90 renewable energy facilities with a total installed capacity of 1 050 MW (284 MW of wind power plants; 542 MW of solar power; 222 MW of small hydroelectric power stations; and 2.4 MW of bioenergy).

The Kazakh Ministry of Energy has developed an action plan to develop 26 GW of additional installed capacity in Kazakhstan by 2035. The plan targets a 2035 installed capacity mix made up of 34.3% of coal, 25.8% of gas, 24.4% of renewables (solar and wind), and 10.8% of hydropower, thus decreasing the share of coal and gas in the country's mix (at the end of ...
