What is the Kyrgyz energy sector development policy operation (esdpo)?

The Kyrgyz Energy Sector Development Policy Operation (ESDPO) was designed to support reforms aimed at reaching long-term energy supply reliability.

How did Kyrgyz government reform the energy sector?

The Kyrgyz authorities undertook significant reforms in 2014 to address energy sector challenges and built needed consensus among stakeholders. The reform measures were anchored in the Power Sector Development Strategy for 2012-2017, the detailed Action Plan for Reforming the Energy Sector in 2013-14, and the sector laws amended in 2014.

How resilient is Kyrgyz economy?

The Kyrgyz economy has demonstrated resilience to shocks since 2010, with growth averaging around five percent. But large fluctuations in annual growth were caused by natural disasters (e.g., a land slide at the largest gold mine), external shocks (food and energy price spikes) and frequent political change.
