

What is Laos wind power project?

It is the first wind power project in Laos and the largest single wind power project undertaken by Chinese enterprises overseas. The project will transmit electricity to Vietnam when completed, the first of its kind in Laos to realize cross-border transmission of new energy power.

Where is a wind farm located in Laos?

The project is located in Sekong and Attapeu, southern provinces of Laos. It includes a 600 MW wind farm, a set-up switchyard and transmission lines. It is the first wind power project in Laos and the largest single wind power project undertaken by Chinese enterprises overseas.
