By 2018, Avi Technologies had installed approximately 2.268MW Solar Panels, 3.2MW Diesel Generators, 3.78MWH Energy Storage Systems across 14 islands of Haa Alif atoll. This project has significantly reduced the energy production cost in the region by harvesting solar energy and reducing dependency on diesel.
