

Malta is building an energy storage battery project

Interconnect Malta, a company within the Ministry for the Environment, Energy and Enterprise, will implement this project on behalf of the Government of Malta, in collaboration with Enemalta plc and its subsidiary company International Energy Service Centre Ltd.

In July, Malta Inc signed a deal with Siemens Energy to co-develop turbomachinery components for its systems and in March Energy-Storage.news reported the company's closing of a US\$50 million funding round, with investors including Facebook co-founder Dustin Moskowitz and Bill Gates' Breakthrough Energy Ventures taking part.

As part of Malta's long-term climate and energy goals to reduce carbon emissions from the energy sector, enhance the integration of renewable energy sources (RES), and strengthen the security of supply, the country is launching the procurement process for the design and construction of two utility-scale Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS).

Based in Cambridge Massachusetts, Malta, Inc. has developed a Pumped Heat Energy Storage (PHES) system to provide long-duration, large-scale, cost-effective, and safe energy storage. Malta's system stores electricity as thermal energy and then re-generates the electricity on demand for 200 hours or longer, meeting daily and weekly needs.

The project Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) consists of the first systems of its kind that will store energy from renewable sources on a large scale. The two projects are being estimated at a cost of EUR35 million at Delimara and a further EUR12 million at Marsa, with the Ministry for the Environment, Energy and Enterprises stating that ...

building a new type of electro-thermal energy storage system that can collect and store energy from any source (i.e. wind, sun, or fossil fuels), in any location and for long durations, and dispatch it as electricity on demand.

In 2021, the Illinois General Assembly passed SB 2408, the Energy Transition Act, an omnibus energy package that cleared a path for Vistra Corp. to build and operate up to 300 MW of utility-scale solar and 150 MW of battery energy storage facilities at nine retired or to-be-retired coal plant sites across central and southern Illinois.
